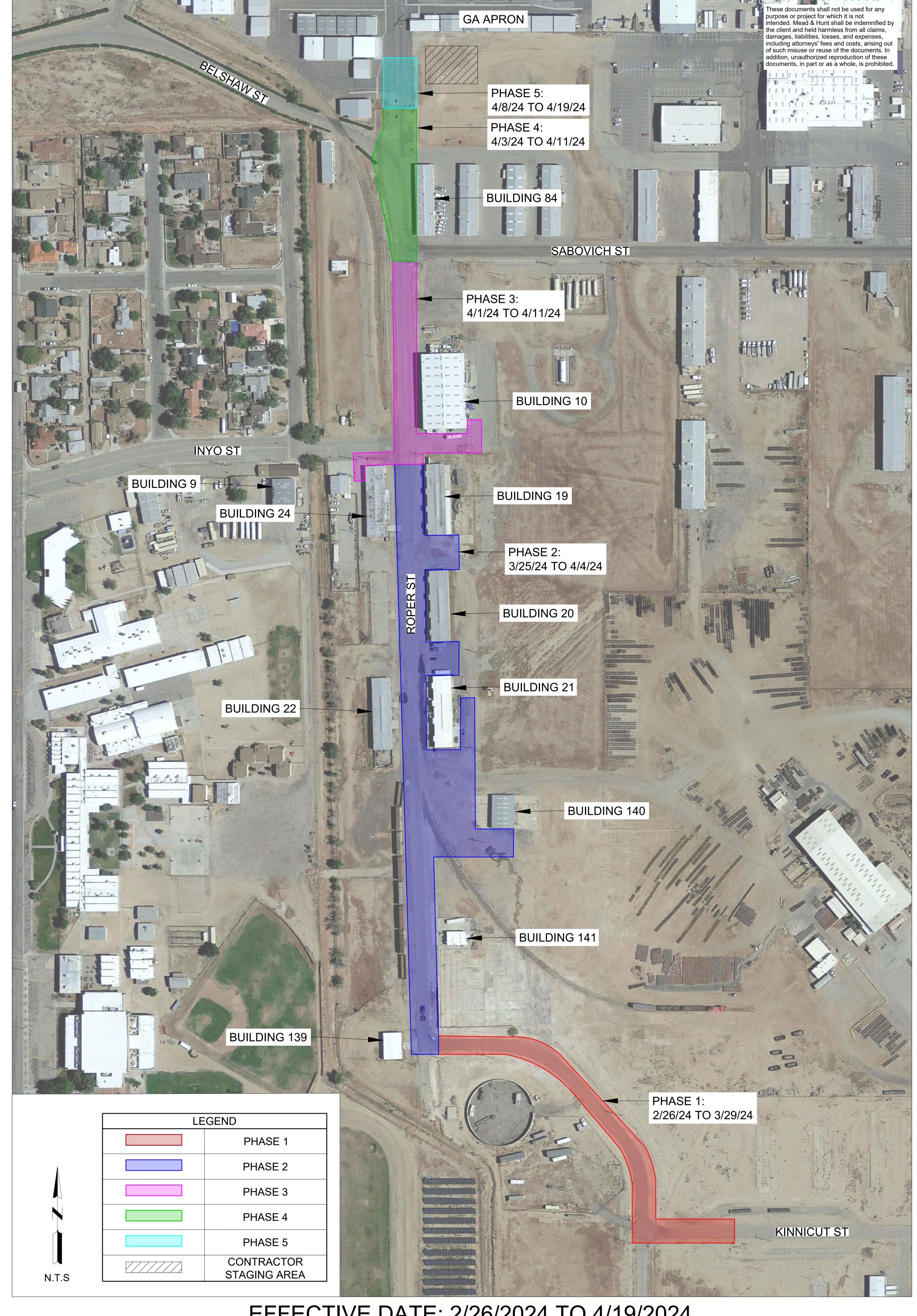

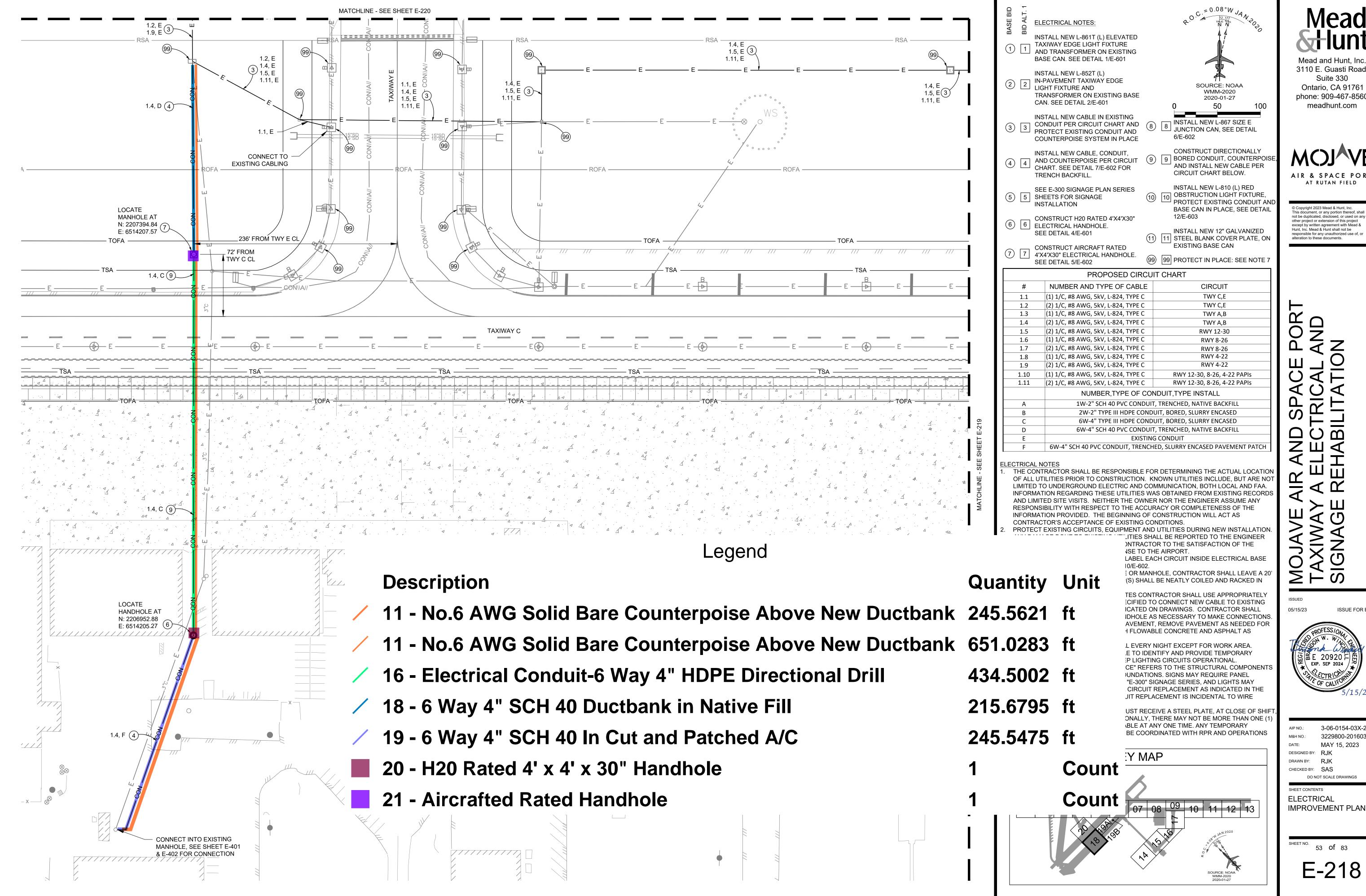

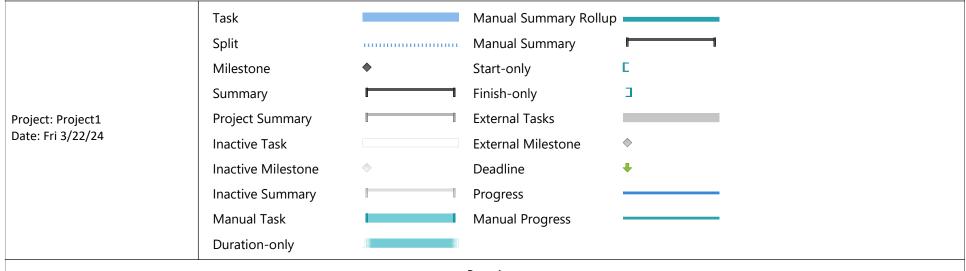

o Beginning training for Virtower users at Mojave.

- Virtower software installed last month to assist with operations tracking, based aircraft tracking, live aircraft feeds. Program will help provide more accurate depictions of aircraft movements in Mojave, which is tied to opportunities for funding.
