SUBJECT: AB 361 Remote Meeting Resolution

MEETING DATE: September 19, 2022

Background:

The Governor's executive order suspending certain requirements of the Brown Act regarding board meetings has expired, but the proclamation of a state of emergency is still in place. The Legislature has amended Govt Code 54953 to include provisions allowing remote meetings during a state of emergency under certain conditions. The attached resolution allows the Board to continue meeting remotely until the state of emergency is lifted and social distancing is no longer recommended or required. If the Board adopts the resolution, it will have to renew the resolution every 30 days.

Impacts:

Fiscal: None

Environmental: This action does not constitute a project and is not subject to CEQA

Legal: None

Recommended Action:

The Board has two options:

- 1. The Board may adopt the resolution and continue with remote meetings during the month of September through, October 18, 2022, or until the state of emergency is lifted; or
- 2. The Board may not adopt the resolution and resume holding meetings in compliance with the requirements of the Brown Act.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MOJAVE AIR AND SPACE PORT PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY, RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY, AND AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2022

WHEREAS, Mojave Air and Space Port (the "District") is committed to encouraging and preserving public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 54953, as amended by AB 361, makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953, subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that there is a proclaimed state of emergency, and state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; and

WHEREAS, Governor Newsom declared a State-wide state of emergency due to the Covid-19 pandemic on March 4, 2020, which declaration is still in effect, and state and local health officials continue to recommend social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the resurgence of the Covid-19 pandemic, particularly through the Delta variant, has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the District that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the District, and desires to proclaim a local emergency and ratify both the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California and the Kern County Health Department guidance regarding social distancing; and

WHEREAS, based on the above the Board of Directors of the District finds that inperson public meetings of the Board would further increase the risk of exposure to the Covid-19 virus to the residents of the District, staff, and Directors; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency, the Board of Directors does hereby find that it shall conduct Board meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, in compliance with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of Board of Directors will be available to the public for participation and comments through virtual measures, which shall be fully explained on each posted agenda.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MOJAVE AIR AND SPACE PORT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. <u>Proclamation of Local Emergency</u>. The Board hereby proclaims that a local emergency now exists throughout the District, as set forth in the recitals.

Section 3. <u>Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency</u>. The Board hereby ratifies the Governor's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of March 4, 2021.

Section 4. <u>Remote Teleconference Meetings</u>. The General Manager, staff, and Board of Directors are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date of Resolution</u>. This Resolution shall take effect on September 19, 2022 and shall be effective until the earlier of (i) October 18, 2022, or such time the Board of Directors adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend the time during which the legislative bodies of WBMWD may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.

Section 6. <u>Termination of this Resolution</u>. This Resolution will automatically terminate on the day that both the Governor's Declaration of Emergency and any local agency guideline for social distancing are no longer in effect.

Updates

→ RWY 12/30 Construction Update

Working on review of final contract and anticipate completion within the next two weeks. The work is tentatively scheduled for mid-April through May, with a total of 34 days of work. During this project intersecting runways 8/26 and 4/22 will need to be closed (but not at the same time) to allow for work within the intersections. Currently working with tenants to ensure they are aware of the anticipated closure dates which may impact their operations.

Runway 12/30 is considered a non-standard runway since it's width is 200 feet wide, and therefore the FAA will only fund runway rehabilitation for pavement 150 feet wide (based on the largest aircraft design group) Runway 12/30 will still need work on the remaining 25 feet on the east and west sides of the runway where the rehabilitation will take place. Mead & Hunt estimate the remaining 50 feet required for rehabilitation will cost approximately \$7 million to complete. Staff is working on finding an alternative funding source to pay for the areas not covered under the AIP grant, which includes applying for a Caltrans grant or possibly asking our congressional representation for assistance. Full width rehabilitation of this runway is essential as the pavement is starting to fail, and if not addressed, will result in total failure over the life of the approved rehabilitation, rendering the runway unusable if not addressed.

→ B3K Aerospace Working Group

Both Todd and I have been working with A Better Bakersfield/Boundless Kern Regional Action for Economic Prosperity in an effort to solidify East Kern and the Antelope Valley as a globally-competitive aerospace hub, and to generate high-quality jobs across skill levels while improving worker access and availability. Essentially, this program will work with MASP and our tenants, along with other aerospace organizations in our region, to foster developing technical trades which are needed in the aerospace industry. Several of our tenants have volunteered to participate in this initiative, and MASP will be participating in a supportive role (such as providing space for regular meetings and facilitating the working group functions). B3K has requested to bring a group of participants to the Airport on October 26 for a tour of some of the participating tenant facilities and to review our operations. Staff will be working with participating tenants to coordinate this tour.
