Background:

Dept. of General Services (CalFire) executed an Eight-year lease on February 4, 2022, for Bunker 37, 278 and adjacent land ending January 31, 2030. The lease has a 2% annual price increase. CalFire is requesting a lease amendment to add Bunker 281 for the remaining term of their lease. The bunkers will be used for fireworks storage.

AMENDMENT TO LEASE

LEASE FILE NO: 7167-001 PROJECT NO: 12610 AMENDMENT NO: One (1)

THIS AMENDMENT TO LEASE, made and entered into this 6th day of March 2024, by and between Mojave Air & Space Port, A California Airport District, hereinafter called Lessor, and the State of California acting by and through the Director of the Department of General Services, hereinafter called the State.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under lease dated February 4, 2022, the State hires from Lessor certain premises located at 1434 Flightline, Mojave, CA as more particularly described in said lease; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend said lease to: (1) add additional space; (2) increase the monthly rental accordingly; and (3) add a paragraph to address Russia Sanctions under Executive Order N-6-22.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. Effective April 1, 2024, the description paragraph of said lease is amended to add thereto Bunker 281 Approximately 1,250 sf. of Bunker as outlined in red on the attached Exhibit "A3" making a new total of approximately 3,300 sf. of Bunker and Approximately 27, 9242 sq. ft. of Unimproved land adjacent to Bunker 37 hired under this lease.
 - 2. Effective April 1, 2024, Paragraph 4 of said lease is modified as follows:

Rental payments shall be paid by the State, from legally available funds and subject to the California Constitution, in arrears on the last day of each month during said term as follows:

TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT AND 84/100 DOLLARS (\$2,890.09) from April 1, 2024, through January 31, 2025; then

TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTEEN AND 02/100 DOLLARS (\$2,947.89) from February 1, 2025, through January 31, 2026; then

TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR AND 34/100 DOLLARS (\$3,006.85) from February 1, 2026, through January 31, 2027; then

THREE THOUSAND THIRTY-THREE AND 83/100 DOLLARS (\$3,066.99) from February 1, 2027, through January 31, 2028; then

THREE THOUSAND NINETY-FOUR AND 51/100 DOLLARS (\$3,128.33) from February 1, 2028, through January 31, 2029; then

THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX AND 40/100 DOLLARS (\$3,190.90) from February 1, 2029, through January 31, 2030; and thereafter.

- 3. No rental shall accrue under this Amendment, nor shall the State have any obligation to perform the covenants or observe the conditions herein contained, until the leased premises have been made ready for occupancy in accordance with the provisions hereof. It is specifically agreed that in the event the leased premises are not completed and ready for occupancy by the State on or before April 1, 2024, then and in that event the State may, at its option and in addition to any other remedies it may have, terminate this Amendment and be relieved of any further obligations thereunder, except that delays caused by (a) acts of the State, its agents or employees, or those claiming under agreement with or grant from the State, or by (b) the acts of God which Lessor could not reasonably have foreseen or guarded against, or by (c) any strikes, boycotts or like obstructive actions by employees or labor organizations and which are beyond control of Lessor and which cannot be reasonably overcome, or by (d) restrictive regulations by the Federal Government which are enforced in connection with a National Emergency, shall be added to said time for completion by a fair and reasonable allowance.
- 4. Lessor hereby agrees that in the event the additional space is completed and ready for occupancy by the State prior to April 1, 2024, the State may if it so elects, take possession and occupy the additional space at the earliest date practical after the date of completion. The rent payable for any such occupancy by the State prior to April 1, 2024 shall be at the rate of \$2,890.09 per month.
- 5. Lessor shall notify the State in writing by certified mail of the date the leased premises will be completed and ready for occupancy at least thirty (30) days prior thereto, and such notice shall be a condition precedent to the accrual of rental hereunder, provided however,

that if the State occupies the premises prior to the receipt of such notice or prior to the expiration of the notice period of such notice, rental shall commence to accrue as of the date of such occupancy.

6. On March 4, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (EO) regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. "Economic Sanctions" refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. The EO directs state agencies to terminate contracts with, and to refrain from entering any new contracts with, individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of Economic Sanctions. Accordingly, should the State determine Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for termination of this agreement. The State shall provide Contractor advance written notice of such termination, allowing Contractor at least 30 calendar days to provide a written response. Termination shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

Except as amended herein, all the terms of said lease hereinabove referred to shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.







Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.
